## Semantic Summary

Chris Wickland, known as "The Vexed Vicar," is a UK Christian nationalist YouTuber and NAR-adjacent prophetic minister who runs the Living Word Church Network from Fareham, Hampshire. With 31,300 YouTube subscribers, he issues prophetic declarations over Britain and its political leaders, blending charismatic Pentecostal "Kingdom Now" eschatology with anti-immigration politics and pro-Reform UK messaging. His flagship video "My Flag, My Nation" epitomises the fusion of Christian nationalism and patriotic symbolism. Analysed by the Centre for the Study of Bible and Violence (CSBV) as operating within the New Apostolic Reformation's prophetic framework, Wickland represents the theological flank of the British far-right — a parallel to Calvin Robinson's defrocked Anglican traditionalism and Ceirion Dewar's breakaway Confessing Anglicanism, but operating from within the charismatic/Pentecostal stream. He has appeared on Andrew and Daphne's podcast discussing Reform UK's rise. His content demonstrates how NAR theology's Seven Mountains mandate — calling Christians to dominate culture, government, and media — provides a theological architecture for far-right political mobilisation, with prophetic declarations functioning as spiritualised endorsements of nationalist policy positions.

## Overview

Chris Wickland is a UK-based Christian minister and YouTuber who runs the **Living Word Church Network** and issues prophetic declarations over Britain and its political leaders. With 31.3K YouTube subscribers, he produces regular videos blending NAR-style prophecy, anti-immigration politics, and Christian nationalist rhetoric.

He is described by the CSBV (Centre for the Study of Bible and Violence) as operating in a comparable style to NAR prophetic office holders. His content sits at the intersection of charismatic pentecostal prophecy and far-right political mobilisation.
