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Semantic Summary

CP Reports is a small-scale UK/Ireland-based YouTube auditing channel operated under the handle CaoimheVlogs, suggesting a female Irish operator named Caoimhe — an unusual demographic profile in the predominantly male UK auditor scene. The channel positions itself against mainstream media, posting about "holding places accountable" and "showing what the MSM don't show." Despite its small following (919 X/Twitter followers), the account has documented presence at pro-Israel vigils at Downing Street and has engaged with Tommy Robinson's network, indicating alignment with the broader far-right activist ecosystem. The channel's modest scale and 2024-2025 creation date suggest an early-stage entrant to the auditing space, with content spanning audit footage, Israel-related activism, and SEND funding advocacy. The operator's attendance at events alongside the far-right activist network — including posting about meeting Tommy Robinson — positions CP Reports within the periphery of the auditor-to-far-right-activist pipeline, even as the channel's limited reach distinguishes it from major players like AY Audits or Auditing Britain.

Overview

CP Reports is a small UK/Ireland-based YouTube auditing channel that describes itself as: *"Auditing holding places accountable and showing what the mainstream media do not show."* The X bio reads: *"My name is CP Reports and I go around showing the facts and what the msm don't show."*

The operator uses the handle **CaoimheVlogs** across X/Twitter, suggesting the real name may be **Caoimhe** (an Irish name, pronounced Kee-va/Quee-va). The channel appears to be in an early stage of growth, with a modest following and limited content output.

Content Focus

Based on X posting activity and channel description, CP Reports focuses on:

- **Auditing and accountability:** Filming in public spaces, confronting institutions, asserting filming rights
- **Israel-related activism:** Attended and posted about Israel vigils at Downing Street, supporting "Bring Them Home" chants
- **Anti-establishment narratives:** Positioning against mainstream media ("what the msm don't show")
- **Protest coverage:** Appears at protests and activist events

Political Alignment & Associations

CP Reports aligns with the broader UK right-wing auditor/activist scene:

- **Tommy Robinson:** Has posted about meeting Tommy Robinson (@TRobinsonNewEra), indicating alignment with the far-right activist network
- **StopTheHate_UK:** Engaged with this anti-Islam/hate monitoring counter-account
- **Pro-Israel stance:** Attended pro-Israel vigils at Downing Street
- **SEND funding petition:** Has posted about Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) funding petitions, suggesting an interest in education/child welfare issues

Notable Activity

- **Israel Vigil (August 2025):** Posted from Downing Street vigil where attendees chanted "Bring Them Home" — supporting Israeli hostages/hostage awareness
- **Anika Arrest Reporting (October 2025):** Posted about "Anika (ani says)" being arrested for breach of bail conditions — tracking/following activist arrests
- Pro-Israel and anti-anti-Israel content
- Regular engagement with UK political and protest-related discourse

Comparison Notes

CP Reports appears to be a **very small-scale** operator compared to established UK auditor channels. Key differences:

- Subscriber count is likely very low (possibly under 1,000 given the channel is not widely referenced)
- Less polished content output compared to channels like AY Audits (134K subs), BBA (120K subs), or Wesley Winter (211K subs)
- The operator appears to be female (based on Irish name Caoimhe), which is relatively unusual in the UK auditor scene (predominantly male)
- Irish name suggests possible Irish/Northern Irish origin, distinguishing from the predominantly English auditor scene
- Channel creation date appears to be 2024-2025 (the Facebook page was created in 2024)
