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Semantic Summary

British neo-Nazi and co-founder, with Alex Davies, of National Action — the most significant neo-Nazi terrorist organisation in modern British history and the first far-right group proscribed under UK terrorism legislation. Founded in 2013 and banned in December 2016, National Action aimed to radicalise disaffected young men towards creating a white ethnostate through accelerationist tactics, using graphic Nazi imagery and celebrating violence, with members linked to a wider neo-Nazi extremist network. Raymond has stated that Davies was the primary founder and that he became involved later, but he was a key figure in the group's formation and ideology. He has been convicted and is likely under supervision; his current status and location are unknown. After the ban, some National Action members migrated to successor organisations and to Patriotic Alternative.

Benjamin Raymond co-founded National Action alongside Alex Davies in 2013, creating what became the most significant neo-Nazi terrorist organisation in modern British history — the first far-right group to be proscribed under UK terrorism legislation. Raymond has stated that Davies was the actual founder and that he became involved after Davies, but was a key figure in the group's formation and ideology.

National Action aimed to radicalise disaffected young men toward creating a white ethnostate through accelerationist tactics. The group used graphic Nazi imagery, celebrated violence, and its members were linked to a wider network of neo-nazi extremists. After the group was banned in December 2016, some members migrated to successor organisations and to Patriotic Alternative.
