Background

Helen Joyce is a former Brazil correspondent and international editor at The Economist. She left journalism to become a full-time anti-trans advocate, joining Sex Matters as director of advocacy. Her 2021 book *Trans: When Ideology Meets Reality* became a foundational text of the gender-critical movement, arguing that trans activism is an ideology that must be opposed.

Timeline

- **1990s-2021:** Career at The Economist — Brazil correspondent, international editor
- **2021:** Published *Trans: When Ideology Meets Reality*
- **2022:** Joined Sex Matters as director of advocacy
- **Jun 2022:** PinkNews reported Joyce said she "wants to reduce the number of trans people" — widely condemned
- **2023-2026:** Regular media spokesperson for Sex Matters; appears on TalkTV, GB News, podcasts

Ideology & Positions

- Core belief: Trans activism is an ideology, not a civil rights movement; the goal should be to "reduce" the number of trans people
- Opposition to self-ID, GRA reform, and conversion therapy bans
- Framing: defending children from "gender ideology" in schools; opposing puberty blockers and youth transition
- Economic framing (from her Economist background): critiques the institutional capture of public bodies by trans advocacy

Controversies & Criticism

- **"Reduce the number of trans people" (Jun 2022):** Explicitly stated goal — PinkNews coverage described it as "chilling"
- **Harry Potter fan fiction incident:** Bluesky discourse reports Joyce was "caught on a train reading racism-tinged sexually abusive Harry Potter fan fiction involving barely legal schoolchildren" — used by critics to highlight hypocrisy
- **Cass Review response (2026):** When Dr Hilary Cass made remarks that were seen as supportive of trans healthcare, Joyce and Sex Matters turned on her — described as "grossly irresponsible" by TERF-world critics (Bluesky, Jun 2026)
- **Described as "not an expert on medicine, the law, sex, gender, or anything but economics"** by critics on Nitter/Bluesky

- **The Economist** — former employer; her journalistic credentials lend institutional weight to her advocacy
