

Kent Audit UK

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Semantic Summary

Kent Audit UK is a Kent-based YouTube auditing channel notable primarily for the unusual age of its primary operator — a 76-year-old man, making him one of the oldest documented figures in the UK auditor subculture. He is frequently joined by an associate using the pseudonym RottDogg, who has served as the channel's public-facing voice in media coverage, defending the use of balaclavas and justifying the practice as holding public bodies to account. The channel operates within the broader auditor ecosystem populated by larger figures like DJ Audits and Auditing Britain but at a significantly smaller scale, focusing on Kent-based locations including shopping centres, police stations, and sensitive sites like the BAE Systems defence facility in Rochester. A Tonbridge Jobcentre audit gained notoriety for allegedly exposing private information visible on staff screens, raising ethical questions that recur across the auditor phenomenon. The channel's profile was elevated by a major Kent Online feature article that provided rare media insight into the auditor subculture's methods and motivations, and the Daily Mail subsequently quoted RottDogg in its broader coverage of the UK auditor trend, positioning Kent Audit UK as a minor but recurring reference point in the national conversation about confrontational public-space filming.

Overview

Kent Audit UK is a Kent-based YouTube auditing channel run primarily by a **76-year-old man** — making him one of the oldest known UK auditors. He does not use a drone but visits sites across Kent on foot, filming from public land. He is frequently joined by an associate who uses the pseudonym **RottDogg**, from Thanet, who spoke to Kent Online on condition of anonymity.

RottDogg told Kent Online: *"We're one of the most heavily surveilled countries on Earth, yet people accept CCTV and dashcams but get triggered by this."*

The channel is part of the broader UK "auditor" phenomenon but operates at a smaller scale than major players like DJ Audits or Auditing Britain. It focuses on Kent-based locations including shopping centres, police stations, supermarkets, and industrial sites.

Notable Content

- Audit of Waitrose in Ramsgate (confrontation with staff)
- Audit of BAE Systems in Rochester (filmed from public land)
- Audits of Kent shopping centres
- Police station audits across Kent
- Jobcentre audits (including Tonbridge Jobcentre audit that went viral for exposing private information visible on staff screens)

Media Coverage

Kent Online (March 2025)

The primary source of media coverage. A feature article titled *"What are auditors and auditing on YouTube? And why are the likes of DJ Audits and Kent Audit UK such a hit with viewers?"* extensively profiles the channel. Key revelations:

- The channel is run by a 76-year-old man
- His associate RottDogg spoke on condition of anonymity
- RottDogg justified the use of balaclavas as "a way of creating our own privacy in public to prevent our identity from being filmed"
- The article explored the broader auditor phenomenon in Kent, noting that "Kent shopping centres, police stations and supermarkets are among the latest places to be hit by YouTube 'auditors'"

Quoted RottDogg in the broader article on UK auditors: *"One of the people behind another popular auditing account Kent Audit, alongside a 76-year-old man, insists the pastime is 'about holding people to account'."*

Reddit Presence

Reddit search results for "Kent Audit UK" were limited compared to larger auditor channels, suggesting the channel has a smaller online footprint. The channel is occasionally referenced in

broader auditor discussion threads on r/AskUK, r/CasualUK, and auditor-specific subreddits, but does not have dedicated discussion threads to the same degree as DJ Audits or The Laughing Auditor.

Controversies

Age and Anonymity

The 76-year-old operator's advanced age is unusual among UK auditors, most of whom are younger men. His use of a balaclava (shared with RottDogg) has drawn criticism — critics argue that covering one's face while filming others in public is hypocritical.

Privacy Concerns

The Tonbridge Jobcentre audit video was notable for allegedly exposing private information visible on staff computer screens, raising questions about the ethics of filming inside government offices.

BAE Systems Audit

Filming at the BAE Systems defence facility in Rochester drew attention due to security sensitivities around defence contractor sites.

Channel Statistics (Approximate)

- Subscribers: Likely under 10K (smaller channel — not confirmed by major analytics platforms)
- Content style: Walking audits, industrial/shopping centre audits, police station audits
- No drone usage
- Active since: At least early 2025

Notes

Kent Audit UK operates at a significantly smaller scale than DJ Audits (~150K subs) or The Laughing Auditor (~60K subs). Its primary significance is twofold: (1) the unusual age of its operator (76 years old), and (2) being the subject of a major Kent Online feature article that provided rare media insight into the UK auditor subculture. The associate RottDogg has become a minor recurring figure in media coverage of the auditor phenomenon.
