

MKR (MKR Audits)

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Semantic Summary

Kelsea-Leigh Cunliffe, operating as MKR Audits under aliases including Kelsea Rouge and "Madamè," is a Manchester-based auditor who was among six Mancunian content creators arrested and charged following police raids in April 2026, as reported by Searchlight Magazine. She was charged alongside Chris Messenger (English Ned), Kyle Clouston (KC Audits), Rachel Davies (My Brakes Don't Work), David Casey (Davethemancpatriot), and Ricky Jones (Slick Tube) — a collective that HOPE not hate describes as a "collection of Mancunian auditors who began mass-producing content during the anti-migrant protests of 2025." Cunliffe was documented by HOPE not hate at the November 2025 Altrincham hotel protest where fireworks were shot at a building housing asylum seekers and residents were told to "jump from windows" — an incident where, as HOPE not hate noted, the auditors' promise to "film every moment" meant their own behaviour was well-documented. She was profiled in the Antifascist Research Collective's "YouTube Grifters" series and featured in HOPE not hate's State of Hate 2026 report. Her channel, like others in the Manchester collective, exemplifies the regional clustering pattern of UK auditing — groups of creators in specific cities who collaborate, cross-promote, and attend protests together, forming localised nodes within the national anti-migrant content network. Her arrest alongside five co-defendants marks one of the larger coordinated police actions against the auditor scene.

Overview

MKR Audits is a Manchester-based YouTube auditor channel run by **Kelsea-Leigh Cunliffe**, who also goes by the aliases Kelsea Rouge and "Madamè." The channel operates under the handle @MKRaudits on YouTube.

Cunliffe is part of a collective of Mancunian auditors who began mass-producing content during anti-migrant protests in the UK in 2025. The channel is associated with other Manchester-area auditors including My Brakes Don't Work (Rachel Davies), English Ned (Chris Messenger), and others.

Notable Content

- Confrontational auditing of government buildings and public spaces
- Coverage of anti-migrant hotel protests (particularly Altrincham)
- Street-level sovereignty content
- Collaboration with other Manchester-based auditors
- Coverage of Britain First rallies

Controversies

Arrest and Charges (April 2026)

- **Searchlight Magazine (April 2026):** Six so-called 'auditors' were arrested and charged following police raids in Manchester. Cunliffe (as MKR Audits) was among those charged, along with:
 - Chris Messenger ('English Ned')
 - Kyle Clouston ('KC Audits')
 - Rachel Davies ('Mybrakesdontwork')
 - David Casey ('Davethemancpatriot')
 - Ricky Jones ('Slick Tube')

Altrincham Hotel Attack

- **HOPE not hate (November 2025):** Documented MKR Audits' presence at a protest where fireworks were shot at a hotel housing asylum seekers and residents were told to "jump from windows." The report notes that auditors promised to film every moment, but this meant their own horrendous behaviour was well-documented.
