

Ryan Ferguson — Neo-Nazi Activist

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Semantic Summary

Ryan Ferguson, 26, of Bootle, Liverpool, is one of Britain's most active and publicly documented neo-Nazi activists, with a trajectory escalating from football hooligan and convicted racist abuser to open National Action-adjacent terrorist-chanting extremist. He wears Nazi "88" (Heil Hitler) regalia, has been filmed shouting "Heil Hitler" at Jewish counter-protesters in Bristol — an incident that led the Bristol Patriots group to suspend operations — organised a "whites only, no blacks" march in Blackpool, broke into asylum hotel bedrooms alongside National Rebirth Party's Harry Jackson, and chanted "National Action is reforming" (referencing the proscribed terrorist group) at protests. He maintains a prison-visitation relationship with convicted National Action terrorist and child sex offender Jack Renshaw. His criminal charges are accumulating across jurisdictions: encouraging violence against police under the Serious Crime Act (Manchester, June 2026), assault by beating and racially aggravated harassment (Warwick, July 2026), plus active hate crime investigations for the Bristol Nazi salute. He has aligned with Restore Britain, calling it the UK's "only hope" and Reform a "base for foreigners." He appeared on Ryan Bridge's Raise the Colours podcast, contributing to defections from the group over extremism concerns. Ferguson represents the most extreme Tier 4 neo-Nazi actor — operating outside electoral politics, providing ideological anchorage for the broader far-right ecosystem, and demonstrating the pattern of multi-jurisdiction charges that rarely result in conviction despite years of documented hate crimes.

Overview

Ryan Ferguson is a self-proclaimed neo-Nazi activist from Merseyside who has become one of the most recognisable figures in the North West's far-right movement. He has evolved from a football hooligan with a history of banning orders and a prison sentence for racially abusing a footballer into a full-time far-right activist with links to the proscribed terrorist organisation **National Action**.

He is known for:

- Wearing Nazi "88" (Heil Hitler) regalia at far-right marches
- Filming himself shouting "Heil Hitler" at Jewish counter-protesters
- Breaking into asylum hotel bedrooms alongside Harry Jackson
- Chanting "National Action is reforming" — referencing a proscribed terrorist group
- Repeated arrests (Liverpool, Hoylake, Bristol) — typically released without charge or on bail

Timeline of Activity

2025

May 2025 — Britain First Birmingham Rally

- Pictured at the front of a Britain First march in Birmingham walking beside co-leaders **Paul Golding** and **Ashlea Simon**
- Wearing a t-shirt with Polish slogan "twoja nienawiść umacnia naszą wiarę" ("your hatred strengthens our faith") and the numbers "**88**" — widely recognised as neo-Nazi shorthand for "Heil Hitler" (H is 8th letter of alphabet, 88 = HH)
- When contacted by the Liverpool Echo, Ferguson said "the political party he worked for prevented him from giving statements"

May 2025 — Britain First Nuneaton Rally

- Attended Britain First rally in Nuneaton alongside National Action activists

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2026

January 2026 — Blackpool "Whites Only" March

- Front of a march organised by Ben Sykes (No Filter Britain) through Blackpool
- Video circulated showing Ferguson telling camera: "Remember at this demo, whites only. No blacks."
- Advertised the event as a "whites only" march
- Maintains relationship with **Jack Renshaw** — convicted neo-Nazi terrorist (National Action) and child sex offender — visiting him in prison

February 2026 — Warwick Protest Incident (Shire Hall)

February 2026 — Liverpool Echo deep-dive

- Liverpool Echo published detailed investigation into Ferguson's evolution from football hooligan to far-right figure
- Analysis found he had become more extreme: reposted Express article about migrant deaths saying "Lovely news... Can this happen a lot more often, maybe the number will drop that are entering our white land."
- X (Twitter) account fluctuates between amassing followers and being taken down for policy breaches

March 2026 — Bristol Patriots March / "Heil Hitler" Video

- Attended a Bristol Patriots march with ~40 far-right activists, protected by ~200 police, mounted units, and baton charges
- Filmed shouting "Heil Hitler" repeatedly at Jewish counter-protesters over a police line
- Also shouted antisemitic abuse, claimed "this is not an offence" on video
- Video went viral across social media
- Six arrests at the protest; Avon & Somerset Police launched hate crime investigation
- Bristol Patriots subsequently announced they were **shutting down their Facebook page and suspending operations** — directly attributed to Ferguson's behaviour at the march

Key Observations

1. **Multi-jurisdiction charges stacking up** — Ferguson now has active cases in three different court systems simultaneously: Manchester (Serious Crime Act), Leamington Spa (assault/racial harassment), and the existing Avon & Somerset investigation (Bristol Nazi salute). If even one sticks, he faces significant time.
2. **Restore party pivot** — Ferguson abandoning Reform for the harder-right Restore is significant. It signals the far-right ecosystem is fragmenting further, with figures like Ferguson gravitating towards parties even Farage can't control.
3. **High arrest frequency but rare convictions for the main offences** — Ferguson has been arrested for Nazi salutes, hate speech, and harassment but often released without charge or on bail. The hoax calls conviction (Aug 2025) and the current Serious Crime Act charge are rare examples of the legal system actually sticking.
4. **Causes groups to shut down** — His behaviour at the Bristol Patriots march in March 2026 was so extreme it directly led to the group suspending operations and deleting their Facebook page. He's a liability even to the far-right groups that host him.
5. **Steady escalation** — From football hooligan → racist abuse convictions → Britain First supporter → neo-Nazi regalia → National Action proscription chanting → asylum hotel break-ins → Heil Hitler on video → BUF pendant + Aryan Fist salutes. The trajectory is clearly deepening rather than moderating.
6. **National Action links are significant** — Chanting "National Action is reforming" at a protest is a serious matter given National Action is a proscribed terrorist organisation under UK terrorism legislation. Visiting Jack Renshaw in prison confirms ongoing connection to the group.

7. **Internal far-right friction** — Accusations against RealityCheckChick as a "plant" suggest internal trust is eroding within his circle, consistent with his pattern of burning bridges even among allies.
8. **Ryan Bridge connection becoming a liability** — Being arrested alongside Bridge for GBH (even if released) links Ferguson to increasingly violent far-right activity beyond his usual MO of Nazi salutes and harassment.
9. **Content farming suspicion** — Multiple observers note his behaviour seems tailored to generate outrage and social media attention. "Always seems to end up heading in the wrong direction" — suggesting staged provocation for content.
