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Semantic Summary

Hardline fascist wing figure, described as an "actual self-confessed Nazi." Associated with Restore Britain, the hard-right splinter that operates to the right of mainstream far-right street movements. Represents the most extreme, ideologically uncompromising edge of the UK far-right ecosystem. T2/T4 — bridges mobilisation and neo-Nazi/extremist cell networks.

Background

Steve Laws is a figure in the hardline fascist wing of the UK far-right, associated with Restore Britain. Described as an "actual self-confessed Nazi," he represents the ideologically purist, explicitly neo-Nazi edge of the movement. Unlike figures who maintain plausible deniability or operate through dog whistles, Laws reportedly embraces the label openly. He has been involved in public denunciations of auditors who film faces that are later used as evidence — part of the "grass" controversy in the far-right YouTube scene where figures like Dion Wragg and Sam Melia publicly condemned auditors whose footage aids prosecutions.

Tier Classification

- **Tier 2** — Mobiliser: participates in street-level organisation
- **Tier 4** — Extremist cell / neo-Nazi faction: ideological purist operating outside electoral arena
