PM warned not to tackle borrowing by scrapping key pension protection

VOTERS WOULD PUNISH YOU IF TRIPLE LOCK GOES

ANDY Burnham has been warned voters will punish him at the ballot box if he scraps the triple lock.

The PM was given the ultimatum by campaigners amid fresh calls for the pension safeguard to be axed to save money, as the government was hit by soaring borrowing costs.

Lord O'Neill, a close ally of the Labour leader, urged him to rein in "excesses" such as the triple lock guarantee that sees state pensions rise each year by the highest of inflation, earnings or 2.5%, to calm financial market turbulence.

But Dennis Reed, director of the Silver Voices group, said: "No political party worth its salt is going into the next general election pledging to scrap or dilute the triple lock."

"All recent opinion polls prove massive public support for the lock, and those ignoring that support will suffer the same fate as the dinosaurs. Instead of heeding these increasingly hysterical calls to scrap the lock, politicians should be
