Hannah Slater, 38, is being treated for incurable cancer which has spread to her brain.

DAME Esther Rantzen has revealed she is too frail to travel to Switzerland to end her life as she demands MPs pass the assisted dying bill today.

The TV legend, 86, who has terminal cancer, had planned to visit Dignitas.

She said: 'Everything I didn't want to happen I'm having to go through now.'

It means the people I love and care about either cannot visit me, or see me

Byline research: Wikipedia REST API (no encyclopaedia articles exist for any of these three bylines — no name-mismatch risk), the papers' own author pages, Muck Rack, and IPSO's full rulings search (searched `ipso.co.uk/?s=<name>`, checked against each hit's summary for the full name — every hit was first-name/surname noise from unrelated complainants). Note: IPSO rulings name the publication, not the reporter, so "no ruling found" cannot prove an article was never complained about.

Daily Express

- **Hanna Geissler** (Health Editor) — cover story byline **Bio:** Health Editor at the Daily Express; writes about UK health news, particularly the NHS and the latest medical research, and occasionally covers foreign news (the 2023 Turkey earthquake and the East Africa hunger crisis). NCTJ-trained at Kingston University, London, and based in London. She led the Express's long-running "Give Us Our Last Rights" assisted dying crusade and collected its British Journalism Awards prize with new formats editor Dan Dove — editor-in-chief Geoff Maynard credited the campaign as "run with decency, respect and skill by Hanna". **Controversies:** None found in public-record searches — no IPSO ruling or correction naming her. Her assisted dying crusade was itself contentious: the award write-up quotes a campaigner saying the Express faced "quite a lot of hostility from certain sections of the media", and the bill the paper campaigned for was defeated in the Commons (286-270) after the cover in question went to press. **Sources:** [Hanna Geissler — Daily Express author page](#), [Hanna Geissler — Muck Rack](#), [Express wins major prize at](#)

Daily Mirror

- **Lucy Thornton** — cover story byline **Bio:** News reporter at the Daily Mirror, where she has worked for more than 30 years, based in Yorkshire and covering national and international news; her Muck Rack profile lists reporter roles at the Mirror and Sunday Mirror with roughly 3,800 published articles. **Controversies:** None found in public-record searches — no IPSO ruling, correction or press row naming her; the IPSO full-text hits for her name are all unrelated complainants (e.g. "Lucy Brown", "Lucy Wyman", "Lucy Jess").

- **Liam Randall** — cover story byline **Bio:** News reporter at the Daily Star and an experienced journalist with a strong grounding in digital media; before joining the Star he was Reach's go-to voice for Wrexham AFC coverage, after years as a Local Democracy Reporter and a Digital Journalist at the Daily Post.
