Mark Collett is a British neo-Nazi activist, leader of Patriotic Alternative, and a longstanding figure in the UK far-right. He operates across multiple tiers of the right-wing YouTube ecosystem (T2/T4/T5) and is known for organising far-right rallies and political events. Collett has been a central organiser in the white nationalist movement for decades, transitioning from the British National Party (BNP) in the 2000s to founding Patriotic Alternative.

Overview

Mark Collett is one of the most prominent neo-Nazi organisers in the UK. He leads Patriotic Alternative, a white nationalist organisation that has become one of the most active far-right groups in Britain. Collett's career spans from the BNP's youth wing in the early 2000s through to his current role as a rally organiser and propagandist.

Background

Collett rose to prominence within the British National Party as a young activist and director of the party's youth wing. He was famously featured in the 2002 Channel 4 documentary *Young, Nazi and Proud*, which exposed his Nazi sympathies. After leaving the BNP, he eventually founded Patriotic Alternative, which has become one of the most significant neo-Nazi organisations in the UK, running regular rallies, summer camps, and propaganda campaigns.
