

Tommy Robinson (Stephen Yaxley-Lennon)

Background

Tommy Robinson (born Stephen Yaxley-Lennon) is Britain's most prominent far-right street activist. He co-founded the English Defence League (EDL) in 2009 in response to Islamic extremism in Luton. The EDL became known for large-scale street demonstrations, often ending in violent clashes with police and anti-fascist counter-protesters. Robinson left the EDL in 2013 citing concerns about far-right extremism within the group, but continued far-right activism independently. He has served multiple prison sentences and has been banned from most mainstream social media platforms.

- **2009:** Co-founded EDL in Luton
- **2011:** Convicted of assault, served 12 months
- **2013:** Left EDL leadership; claimed to be working with Quilliam counter-extremism think tank (briefly)
- **2014:** Convicted of mortgage fraud, sentenced to 18 months
- **2018:** Jailed for contempt of court after filming outside a grooming gang trial; sentence later quashed on appeal
- **2018-2019:** Banned from Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube, PayPal

- **2024-2025:** Active in anti-immigration protests; Southport riots amplification
- **2025-2026:** Large Telegram channel (660K+ views per post); spreading "No Farmers No Food" and "remigration" narratives

Ideology & Positions

- Anti-Islam: core focus on "Islamification" of Britain, "grooming gangs," and "two-tier policing"
- Anti-immigration: "remigration" framing; opposition to asylum seekers
- Anti-establishment: "free speech martyr" narrative; claims to be silenced by the state
- Pro-Reform UK adjacency: not formally affiliated but shares audience and tropes
- "No Farmers No Food" amplification: climate denial crossover

- **X/Twitter** — reinstated 2022 under Musk
- **Rumble / alternative platforms** — secondary distribution
- **Former EDL network** — residual connections to street-fighting far-right
