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Semantic Summary

UKSploosh is a mid-tier UK right-wing YouTube channel with approximately 42,400 subscribers and 4.27 million total views that functions as a protest-coverage and live-streaming node within the broader anti-migrant content ecosystem. The channel's content focuses heavily on weekly protests at the Crowborough migrant accommodation site — covered for over 32 consecutive weeks — alongside anti-migrant demonstrations in Southampton, Braintree, and coverage of the "Unite the Kingdom" rallies. UKSploosh amplifies the Henry Nowak murder case as an anti-migrant framing device, promotes the "two-tier Britain" narrative targeting Keir Starmer's government, and cross-promotes content from Tommy Robinson, Dan Wootton, Danny Tommo, and Chris Cork. The channel's X/Twitter presence (@UKSploosh, approximately 4,000 followers) serves primarily as a promotion feed for YouTube live streams, retweeting far-right figures and framing UTK as "the largest patriotic display the world has ever seen." UKSploosh sits within the broader auditor and protest-media ecosystem documented by Reuters, Channel 4, Novara Media, and HOPE not hate, alongside channels like Marti Blagborough and Society X. Its sustained focus on the Crowborough protests — documenting a single site over many months — exemplifies how individual auditor channels can become the primary media narrators for specific local flashpoints, shaping public perception of migrant accommodation through repetitive, confrontational coverage that mainstream outlets do not match in frequency or framing.

Overview

UKSploosh is a UK-based YouTube channel with approximately 42,400 subscribers and 4.27 million total views. The channel describes itself as providing "Live streams & Videos for supporting the U.K, along with videos and shorts of different events, day in the life." Content focuses heavily on protest coverage -- particularly anti-migrant/asylum hotel demonstrations, live streams of UK protest events, and right-wing political commentary in the "auditor" vein.

Part of the wider UK right-wing YouTube auditor ecosystem alongside channels like Marti Blagborough, AY Audits, Bare Britain Audits, AJ Audits, and others who film outside migrant accommodation and protest events.

Notable Content & Coverage

- **Crowborough Migrant Camp** — Covers weekly protests (ongoing, reported at 32+ weeks) at the Crowborough migrant accommodation site, claiming migrants are working illegally at local companies
- **Southampton** — Live streams of anti-migrant protests
- **Braintree** — Live coverage
- **Henry Nowak** — Multiple posts referencing the Henry Nowak murder case ("Remember his name... Henry Nowak"), used to frame anti-migrant narrative
- **UTK (Unite The Kingdom)** — Promoted the 16 May 2026 "Unite The Kingdom and the West" rally in London; covered the route walk
- **Two-Tier Britain** — Framing Keir Starmer/UK government as applying different standards to right-wing activists vs. others
- Cross-promotional ecosystem with Tommy Robinson (Stephen Yaxley-Lennon), Dan Wootton, Danny Tommo, Chris Cork, and others

X/Twitter Activity

The @UKSploosh account acts primarily as a promotion channel for YouTube live streams. Activity includes:

- Live stream announcements with piped.video links
- Retweeting/amplifying content from Tommy Robinson, Scoop Urban, and other far-right figures
- Coverage of the UTK rally as "the largest patriotic display the world has ever seen"
- Claims of "two-tier Britain" and criticism of Starmer for allegedly banning US right-wing figures (D Tarczynski, Don Keith, Joey Mannarino) from entering the UK while meeting with Ahmed al-Sharaa
- Framing of anti-migrant protests as legitimate patriotic expression
- Reference to "lefties" refusing to join a minute's clap for Henry Nowak

Ecosystem Context

UKSploosh sits within the broader UK "auditor" scene -- content creators who film outside migrant hotels, protest sites, and government buildings, often framing it as citizen journalism. This ecosystem has been investigated by:
