

# Posie Parker (Kellie-Jay Keen-Minshull)

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## Semantic Summary

British anti-trans street activist, leader of Party of Women, founder of Standing for Women. CPAC-funded international "Let Women Speak" tour with neo-Nazi attendees. Heritage Foundation connections via Hands Across the Aisle. Explicitly "not a feminist." Associated with Tommy Robinson and far-right figures. Connected to JK Rowling (same network), Elon Musk (amplification), Andrew Tate. Denied Australian visa for CPAC 2025. Operates at intersection of anti-trans activism and far-right nationalism.

## Background

Kellie-Jay Keen is a British anti-transgender and gender-critical activist. She is the leader of the political party **Party of Women**. She describes herself as a women's rights activist but explicitly states she is "not a feminist." Her alias "Posie Parker" originated from her earlier career as a commercial photographer and business selling children's clothing.

# Timeline

- **2019:** Founded **Standing for Women** — organising "Let Women Speak" events opposing GRA reform
- **2022–2023:** International "Let Women Speak" tour across Australia and New Zealand, sponsored/funded by **CPAC** (US conservative organisation)
- **Mar 2023:** New Zealand event in Auckland cancelled after neo-Nazis attended in support; Parker gave a speech declaring she was "not a feminist"
- **Apr 2023:** Belfast event — heavy police presence required
- **2023:** Announced on GB News plans to form a political party and stand against Keir Starmer
- **2024:** **Party of Women** launched as a registered political party
- **2025:** CPAC Australia — was denied a visa to enter Australia for the CPAC event
- **2026:** Active on X/Twitter; continued posing with far-right figures

## Ideology & Positions

- Anti-trans activism: core focus on excluding trans women from women's spaces
- "Not a feminist" — self-described, distinguishing herself from feminist tradition
- Aligned with far-right framing on immigration and Islam (Nitter search shows cross-links with Tommy Robinson)
- "Let Women Speak" framing — claims to defend women's free speech while platforming far-right allies

## Funding & Affiliations

- **CPAC (Conservative Political Action Conference)** — sponsored/funded her Australia/NZ tour; financial backing for international events
- **Heritage Foundation** — linked through Hands Across the Aisle network; reportedly in direct contact requesting support (Bluesky, 2024)
- **Standing for Women** — founder
- **Party of Women** — leader
- **GB News** — regular platform; announced political party on their broadcast
- Denied Australian visa for CPAC event (2025)

## Online Presence & Reach

- **X/Twitter:** Active — engages in public spats (e.g. attack on Pedro Pascal backfired)
- **GB News:** Regular media appearances

- **YouTube:** "Let Women Speak" event coverage
- **Bluesky:** No active presence — discussed as an antagonist in counter-discourse. Noted as "funded by CPAC, racist, mates with Tommy Robinson" (Jul 2026)
- Nitter search (Jul 2026): Active discourse; repeatedly linked with CPAC, Heritage Foundation, Tommy Robinson, Elon Musk, JK Rowling, Andrew Tate as part of the same network

## Controversies & Criticism

- **Neo-Nazi attendance at events:** Multiple "Let Women Speak" events attended by neo-Nazis; Parker did not distance herself
- **HOPE not hate State of Hate 2023:** Documented anti-LGBTQ+ rhetoric becoming "increasingly vocal and aggressive among the far right"
- **"Not a feminist" statement:** Undermines her claim to women's rights advocacy
- **Racism allegations:** Nitter discourse describes her as racist; associations with Tommy Robinson
- **Hands Across the Aisle:** Linked to this US-based network connecting anti-trans activists with Republican operatives
- **Visa denied to Australia (2025):** Blocked from entering for CPAC event
