

# Avi Lasarow — Associate & Donor to Nigel Farage

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## Semantic Summary

Avi Lasarow is a minor figure in Reform UK's donor network — a South African businessman who gifted Nigel Farage three boxing match tickets valued at £1,749, registered in Farage's MP declaration of interests. His significance lies not in the sum but in what he represents: the breadth of Farage's gift/reward network, which alongside his £700,000 GB News salary and undisclosed £5 million Christopher Harborne gift pushed Farage's total registered financial interests past £2 million since July 2024. Lasarow's inclusion alongside mega-donors like Harborne, Yusuf, and Delo illustrates the layered nature of Farage's funding — from billion-pound crypto fortunes to four-figure hospitality gifts — and the opacity of which relationships genuinely influence policy versus which are merely transactional courtesies. The £2 million+ figure itself has become a widely cited statistic illustrating how Farage has monetised his political position to an extent unprecedented among sitting UK MPs.

(£98k/month, £700k total) dominates the discussion more than individual minor donors.
