Semantic Summary

Harry Jackson is a far-right activist and YouTuber affiliated with the National Rebirth Party (NRP), the fascist microparty led by Alex Yerbury. He operates alongside neo-Nazi figure Ryan Ferguson, with whom he collaborates on content and shares a close working relationship — Jackson's YouTube channel "Jackson Media" (10,000+ subscribers) frequently films Ferguson at events around the country. Together, the pair broke into asylum hotel bedrooms at The Richmond hotel in Liverpool, testing unlocked doors, bursting into residents' rooms, and telling non-white occupants they were "going home." Both were subsequently charged with threatening behaviour, racially or religiously aggravated harassment, and aggravated trespass following the 12 July 2025 incident. Jackson faces additional charges from August 2025, including common assault against a complainant on William Brown Street and a further count of racially or religiously aggravated intentional harassment against Haaris Qureshi. At a Liverpool Magistrates' Court hearing on 1 April 2026, both men pleaded not guilty and were granted unconditional bail, with a case management hearing set for 24 April 2026. Jackson was warned by the bench after appearing to laugh during proceedings. Within the auditor-verse drama ecosystem, Jackson has been named as "the one that got English Ned // KC Audits house raided" — meaning he is alleged to have provided information that led to police raids on the Manchester auditor network, earning him a reputation as either a source of intelligence or a liability, depending on faction. Jackson represents the Tier 4 content-creator/foot-soldier hybrid: a YouTuber who monetises far-right confrontation while also participating directly in criminal trespass and harassment.

Overview

Harry Jackson is a far-right activist and YouTube content creator operating within the **National Rebirth Party (NRP)** — a fascist microparty led by **Alex Yerbury** — and in close collaboration with neo-Nazi figure **Ryan Ferguson**. His YouTube channel, **Jackson Media**, has over 10,000

subscribers and primarily features footage of Ferguson at far-right events around the country.

Jackson achieved particular notoriety for his role in **asylum hotel break-ins** alongside Ferguson, where the pair filmed themselves entering hotel bedrooms housing asylum seekers, testing doors, and confronting residents. This content, which forms part of a broader genre of far-right "migrant-hunting" YouTube content, led to criminal charges against both men.

Jackson faces a string of charges across multiple incidents in Liverpool during summer 2025, including threatening behaviour, racially or religiously aggravated harassment, aggravated trespass, and common assault. Both he and Ferguson pleaded not guilty at Liverpool Magistrates' Court on 1 April 2026 and were granted unconditional bail.

Within the far-right auditor scene, Jackson has additionally been identified as the person who allegedly "got English Ned // KC Audits house raided" — meaning he is accused of providing information that led to the Manchester police raids on the auditor network in early 2026, placing him at the centre of internal factional distrust.

Asylum Hotel Break-ins (with Ryan Ferguson)

Jackson, alongside Ryan Ferguson, filmed and participated in **breaking into asylum hotel bedrooms** at The Richmond hotel on Hatton Garden, Liverpool. Their modus operandi involved:

- Testing unlocked doors and entering occupied bedrooms

- Filming residents without consent
- Confronting non-white residents and telling them they were "going home"
- Uploading footage to Jackson's YouTube channel, Jackson Media

This activity is documented in the `uk-far-right-social-media-tropes.md` tracker file and has been covered by Searchlight Magazine and HOPE not hate in their case files on far-right auditors.

The Richmond hotel had been a "recurring flashpoint" for anti-migration protests throughout 2025.

Court Appearance (1 April 2026)

At Liverpool Magistrates' Court on 1 April 2026:

- Both Jackson and Ferguson entered **not guilty pleas** to all charges
 - Both opted for **trial before magistrates**
 - Ferguson refused to state his address in open court, responding "no comment" and citing "the presence of the mainstream media" before eventually giving an address in Derby
 - Jackson was **warned by the bench** after appearing to laugh during proceedings — magistrates reminded him that contempt of court carries consequences
 - Both were granted **unconditional bail**
 - Magistrates described the matter as "complicated"
 - A **case management hearing** was scheduled for 24 April 2026
 - Far-right supporters filled the public gallery; photographs outside court showed the pair "surrounded by backers"

The National Rebirth Party is a fascist microparty within the broader ethnonationalist ecosystem. NRP leader Alex Yerbury has been documented singling out auditors (specifically Young Bob/Thomas Moffitt) for criticism over footage used in prosecutions, and has appeared at events alongside Britain First co-leader Ashlea Simon and ethnonationalist Hugh Anthony.

Key Relationships

- **Ryan Ferguson (Neo-Nazi activist)** — Primary collaborator; Jackson films Ferguson at events nationwide; they conducted hotel break-ins together; both face joint charges
 - **Alex Yerbury (NRP leader)** — Party leader; Yerbury leads the National Rebirth Party and has been documented criticising auditors for providing evidence used in far-right prosecutions
 - **English Ned (Chris Messenger)** — Jackson allegedly provided information leading to the police raids on English Ned and the Manchester auditor network; a Facebook post stated "Harry Jackson" was "the one that got English Ned // KC Audits house raided etc"
 - **KC Audits (Kyle Clouston)** — Also affected by the alleged information Jackson provided to police

The "Grass" Allegation — Auditor Network Infighting

Jackson occupies a contested position in the far-right auditor ecosystem. A post in the **Audit The Auditors UK** Facebook group (72.6K members) named Harry Jackson as the person who "got English Ned // KC Audits house raided" — suggesting Jackson provided information to police that led to the March 2026 raids on the Manchester auditor network (the "Manchester Six" affray case).

This places Jackson at the intersection of two far-right subcultures:

- The **National Rebirth Party / street activist** scene, where he is an active participant
- The **auditor-verse**, where he is viewed with suspicion as a potential informant

Given the far right's extreme hostility towards perceived "grasses" — as demonstrated by Dion Wragg's prison rant and the wider anti-auditor backlash — this allegation carries significant reputational risk for Jackson within his own ecosystem.
