

Rupert Lowe vs Reform UK — Recent Developments

Overview

Rupert Lowe continues to position Restore Britain as the harder-right alternative to Nigel Farage's Reform UK. The split between the two camps remains entrenched, with Restore Britain making electoral inroads in Norfolk while Reform's own internal pressures mount. This briefing covers the most recent developments from the past week.

Key Stories

1. Restore Britain Contests Norfolk PCC By-Election — Reform Wins

Reform UK's **Colin Sutton** won the **Norfolk Police and Crime Commissioner by-election** with 26.7% of the vote. Restore Britain came sixth with **10.9%** — a respectable showing for a new party, but behind the Greens (13.8%) and Independents (13.4%).

2. Lowe Secures Commons Debate on Mass Deportations

Rupert Lowe secured a Parliamentary debate on mass deportations. Reform MPs reportedly agreed with his position — deport every illegal immigrant and send millions of legal migrants home — highlighting the policy convergence between the two parties even as the personal and political split deepens.

3. Investigation Finds Neo-Fascists Inside Restore Britain Branches

A new investigation has found that **Hitler admirers, neo-fascists, and ethnic cleanser supporters are installed in Restore Britain's local branches** (@PoliticsUK on X). This mirrors earlier concerns flagged in the existing profile — including the presence of Steve Laws (described by other far-right figures as a "self-confessed Nazi") in the party's orbit.

This raises questions about Restore Britain's vetting processes and its ability to manage the extremist elements that Farage has tried (with mixed success) to keep at arm's length from Reform.

4. Lowe's Official Account: Anti-Pakistan Messaging

Rupert Lowe's official X account (@RupertLowe10) has been active with hardline messaging:

- Calling **Pakistan a "rogue state"** and promising a Restore Britain government would cut all foreign aid, end immigration from Pakistan, and deport "countless Pakistani rapists, criminals and freeloaders"

- Claiming the government handed Pakistan **£153 million** in foreign aid
- Thanking thousands of patriots who voted for **Restore Britain across Norfolk**

5. Elon Musk Links — Still Murky

Elon Musk's reported interest in Lowe and Restore Britain continues to be a talking point on X, with Musk allegedly suggesting Lowe could be a successor to Farage following Farage's refusal to endorse Tommy Robinson. No concrete funding has been publicly confirmed, but the possibility of Musk-backed funding for a hardline mass-deportation party remains an active undercurrent.

6. Farage Under Pressure — Commons Standards Inquiry

Nigel Farage launched a **preemptive attack on the Commons standards committee** (8 July 2026), claiming it wouldn't judge him fairly. The Guardian's politics live blog (tagged with both Farage and Lowe) noted that Farage also told the Daily Mail he "did not anticipate" that main parties would not stand candidates in the Clacton by-election. The standards inquiry relates to the **£5m "gift" scandal** — with allegations that Farage wanted compensation for forgoing his GB News salary.

Lowe's camp has predictably used this to argue that Farage is establishment, not insurgent.
