Semantic Summary

Sarah White is a far-right street activist and mobiliser who co-organisier the Pink Ladies anti-immigration movement alongside Orla Minihane, leading sustained protests at the Bell Hotel in Epping, Essex from summer 2025. She represents the Advance UK organisational strand of the Pink Ladies movement — while Minihane brought the Restore Britain/Reform UK political connections, White brought the Advance UK far-right splinter infrastructure. She has been arrested at an Epping protest and gave interviews to GB News defending her actions. White has been documented at the Polish Independence Day march in Warsaw, where Searchlight Magazine described her "drooling over Tommy Robinson." She speaks from the stage at Pink Ladies events alongside Nick Tenconi (former UKIP leader, accused of Nazi salutes), and was named in the HOPE not hate February 2026 intelligence case file on Local Anti-Migrant Groups alongside Minihane as a movement leader. She also appeared at the Crowborough anti-asylum demonstration in January 2026, speaking from the stage alongside Advance UK figures and Raise the Colours' Ryan Bridge. White embodies the Advance UK-to-Pink-Ladies pipeline — a mobiliser who bridges the splinter-party organisational infrastructure with the street-level women-led anti-migrant protest movement, demonstrating how far-right groups exploit gender-framed activism to normalise ethno-nationalist street action.

Background

Sarah White is a far-right activist and street mobiliser based in Epping, Essex. Described by Searchlight Magazine as a "loud-mouthed, far-right Advance UK Epping organiser," she came to prominence in summer 2025 as a co-organiser of the Pink Ladies movement, the anti-immigration women's group that emerged following the attempted sexual assault of a 14-year-old girl at Epping's Bell Hotel.

White co-led the sustained protest campaign at the Bell Hotel alongside Orla Minihane. While Minihane brought the political connections (Reform UK vice-chair, Restore Britain spokeswoman, Deloitte consultant), White represented the Advance UK organisational infrastructure — Advance UK being the splinter party from UKIP led by Ben Habib, which operates as a vehicle for hardline anti-immigration street politics.

White has organisational discipline beyond the Pink Ladies: she is a listed organiser for Advance UK, attends international far-right events (Polish Independence Day march in Warsaw), and has been photographed alongside Tommy Robinson. Her arrest at the Epping protests added to her credibility within far-right circles, and she leveraged media appearances on GB News to amplify Pink Ladies messaging.

Activity / Arrests

Bell Hotel Protests (Summer–Autumn 2025)

White co-organised the sustained anti-asylum campaign at the Bell Hotel in Epping with Orla Minihane. The protests drew national attention and featured joint appearances with figures from across the far-right ecosystem, including neo-Nazi Callum Barker (Homeland Party, later Restore Britain), who shared a stage with Minihane.

Arrest — October 2025

White was arrested at one of the Epping protests. She subsequently gave interviews to GB News defending her actions and presenting the Pink Ladies as victims of political persecution. The arrest was reported in Searchlight Magazine's coverage of the Advance UK / Pink Ladies network.

Crowborough (January 2026)

White spoke from the stage at the Crowborough anti-asylum demonstration, appearing alongside Howard Cox (Advance UK) and Ryan Bridge (Raise the Colours). This event was covered by The Argus, LBC, Getty Images, and Alamy, giving White mainstream media visibility beyond the far-right press.

Polish Independence Day — Warsaw

White attended the far-right Polish Independence Day march in Warsaw, where Searchlight Magazine documented her proximity to Tommy Robinson and other international far-right figures.
